The Oshawa Dodgers announce the signing of infielder Rickey Thomas Jr. Thomas played 3rd base for the Huston-Tillotson University Rams in the 2007 season hitting .344 with 7 home runs, 3 triples, and 14 doubles knocking in 61 RBI's. He was on the 2007 RRAC All-Conference 2nd team. Thomas has just returned from Belgium where he excelled with the Brasschaat Braves and in 2008 played in the Venezuelan Winter League.

On the season Fillier is currently batting .355 – 6th best in the Intercounty Baseball League. Fillier leads the Dodgers in runs scored (17), hits (27), doubles (7) and Triples (1). Fillier is the only Oshawa Dodger to be recognized twice as player of the week this season.
